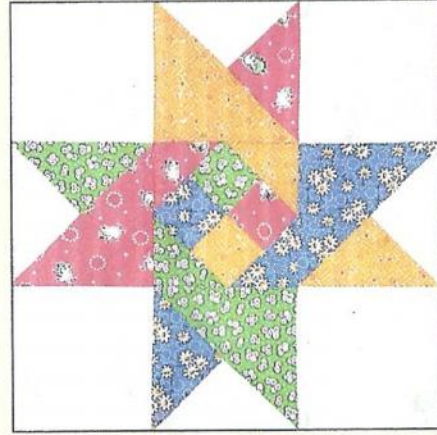

1 square (A) 2" x 2"

1 square (B) 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" ▣ (B)

1 square (C) 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" ▣ (C)

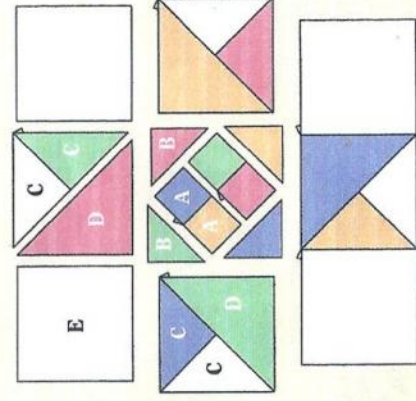
1 square (D) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" ▣ (D)

Cream Tone-on-Tone

1 square (E) 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" ▣ (C)

4 squares (E) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

If you make just one block, you will have extra B, C and D patches. Noticing the placement of the various prints, join the patches as shown in the diagram to make the block. ▣

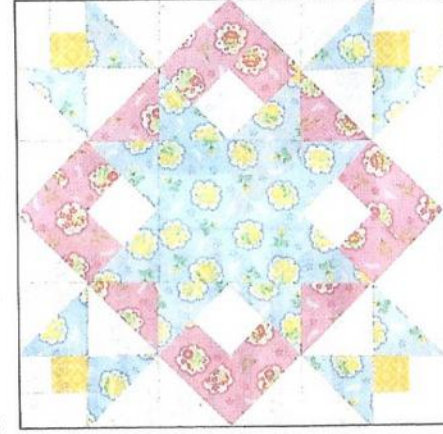

White Tone-on-Tone

6 squares (A) 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

4 squares (B) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

4 rectangles (C) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

4 squares (D) 1 7/8" x 1 7/8"

4 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" ▣ (E)

Blue Print

4 squares (A) 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

4 squares 2 7/8" x 2 7/8" ▣ (E)

1 square (G) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Pink Print

2 squares (A) 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

4 squares (D) 1 7/8" x 1 7/8"

4 rectangles (F) 1 7/8" x 3 1/4"

Yellow Print

4 squares (B) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

Refer to the "Triangle-Squares" technique on page 10. Use the blue and the white A's to make 8 unit 1's. Use the pink and the white A's to make 4 unit 2's.

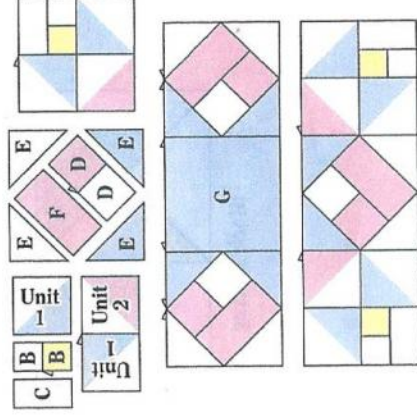


Unit 1
