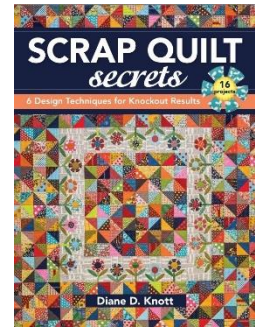

***Scrap Quilt Secrets***

Learn specific strategies for making quilts you love from the fabric you already have! I will share the secrets and steps I use for making scrap quilts that really sparkle. Learn how to avoid the “jumbled mess” look and create quilts you can live with and love. Featuring all 16 quilts from my book SCRAP QUILT SECRETS by C&T (plus many more!)



**Workshop 1:00 – 4:00 PM**

***Under the Mistletoe***

Learn the techniques for paper piecing and sewing curves for excellent results every time! Find out for yourself that curves are NOT scary! Suitable for confident beginners through advanced quilters. Table Runner version is included in this workshop. Covers basic flip and sew paper piecing as well as template sewing. Handouts and pattern included. We will complete one complete unit of four so all steps are practiced, then it's only repeating what we've done after class. Warning: It's addictive!



- sewing machine with all its parts, extension cord and power strip
- iron and pressing pad (community pressing stations are great)
- rotary cutting mat, ruler and cutter
- fabric and paper scissors
- pencil and paper for notes
- thread and bobbins
- pins
- add a quarter ruler, if available
- pressing tool for seams, if available
- freezer paper for templates
- seam ripper (just in case)

**Fabric suggestions:** fat quarters or fat eighths (8-10) are great, pre-cutting strips is NOT recommended. Pre-pressing and rolling or laying the fabrics flat will save class time. This is also a great opportunity for fabric swaps to increase variety. One yard of background fabric will be plenty to work with, no need to bring all of it.

**Diane Knott** made her first quilt in 1997. In 2012, and many quilts later, she created the online pattern company and website called Butterfly Threads Quilting to distinguish herself from the other Diane Knott (who is a talented fabric designer in the quilting industry.) She has published over a dozen patterns, created three templates, been featured in Quilt Magazine, Primitive Quilts and Patchwork, Fons and Porter Easy Quilts, and the American Patchwork and Quilting Calendar.



In addition to traveling and teaching from her two books published by C&T, *Scrap Quilt Secrets* and *Strip Quilt Secrets*, Diane enjoys making custom quilts for hire and longarm quilting for others.
