
BITS AND PIECES

We have just a few blocks to finish up; so if you haven’t finished all your blocks from previous rounds, NO WORRIES! You have the whole month to catch up.

****MYSTERY CHALLENGE**** After finishing the items below, you will have all the blocks & pieces you will need to make your quilt. If you think you know how the quilt will be put together, sketch it out or take a picture of your block layout – AND BRING IT TO JUNE’S GUILD MEETING. It will be fun to see what you come up with. I will demo and hand out the actual quilt top assembly instructions in June.



****BIG REVEAL**** We are planning on having the “Big Reveal” in August with a special Show And Tell. So try to have your quilt top or finished quilt ready by then. There will be awards and prizes for all participants

5.J	Internal border & Star Centers (save for later) Fabric B – cut 2 ½" strips WOF Fabric B – cut 2 ½" squares (from scraps)	6 – 2 ½" Strps 5 - 2 ½" Sqs	7 – 2 ½" Strps 8 – 2 ½" Sqs	7 – 2 ½" Strps 8 – 2 ½" Sqs	11-1 ½" Strps 13 – 2 ½" Sqs
5.K	Chevron Side Sashings The chevrons should measure 13 ½" long. If your chevrons are consistently longer or shorter, <u>not to worry</u> . Measure them and average and come up with your own chevron length. Then substitute that measurement for the 13 ½". <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cut 13 ½" x WOF strips of Fabric B - Subcut into 13 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles - Sew one Sashing onto right side of each chevron. Remaining 4 to be used later. 	N/A	N/A	Fabric B 2 – 13 ½" x WOF Strps Subcut: 32 – 13 ½"x2 ½" rectangles	Fabric B 3 – 13 ½" x WOF Strps Subcut: 36 – 13 ½"x2 ½" rectangles

5.K	Corners: First Cut Fabric D (2 nd fabric in chevron) – cut 4" Squares Fabric E (3 rd fabric) – cut 3 ¼" x WOF strips Fabric F (4 th fabric) – cut 3 ¼" x WOF strips	N/A	N/A	4 – 4" Sqs 2 – 3 ¼" Strps 2 – 3 ¼" Strps	4 – 4" Sqs 2 – 3 ¼" Strps 2 – 3 ¼" Strps
5.L	Fabric E – subcut & sew: - Four (4) 4" x 3 ¼" rectangles – sew one to one side of Fabric D Square. Repeat - Four (4) 6 ¾" x 3 ¼" rectangles – sew one to adjacent side of Fabric D Square & smaller rectangle. Repeat	N/A	N/A	4– 4" x 3 ¼" 4– 6 ¾" x 3 ¼"	4 – 4" x 3 ¼" 4– 6 ¾" x 3 ¼"
5.M	Fabric F – subcut & sew: - Four (4) 6 ¾" x 3 ¼" rectangles – sew one to one side of 5.L unit above. Repeat. - Four (4) 9 ½" x 3 ¼" rectangles – sew one to adjacent side of 5.L unit above. Repeat - Results are 9 ½" squares. After adding the 4 ½" Fabric C Strip (Step 5.N), your corner should equal the length of your chevrons. 5.N	Fabric C – cut, subcut and sew: - Cut three (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips - Subcut into four (4) 9 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles – sew one to one side of 5.M unit. Repeat. - Subcut into four (4) 13 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles – sew one to adjacent side of 5.M unit. 5.P	Cornerstones – First Cut Select any of your medium fabrics (D, E, F or G) and cut the following: Cut 4 ½" squares from one Medium Fabric Cut 2 ½" squares from one Medium Fabric (these will be used later in quilt assembly) Cut 2 ½" squares from Fabric A	4 – 4 ½" Sqs 20 – 2 ½" Sqs 16 – 2 ½" Sqs	4 – 4 ½" Sqs 27 – 2 ½" Sqs 16 – 2 ½" Sqs	4 – 4 ½" Sqs 27 – 2 ½" Sqs 16 – 2 ½" Sqs	4 – 4 ½" Sqs 36 – 2 ½" Sqs 16 – 2 ½" Sqs
5.Q	Square in Square 1. Fold 2 ½" squares of Fabric A (5.P) in half diagonally, wrong sides together and press. (Or you can draw a diagonal line on wrong side that will not show through.) 2. Align 2 ½" squares with opposite corners of the 4 ½" square of your chosen Medium (5P), right sides together. 3. Sew along fold (or drawn) line. (Consider sewing 1 thread outside the line). Press toward corner.				

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	4. Trim bottom two layers to ¼" seam allowance.				
5.Q	5. Align 2 ½" squares of Fabric A on the remaining two opposing corners. Sew & press & trim as in #3 & #4 above.				
5.Q	6. Ensure that the 4 ½" square is still approximately square; or resew. 7. Result is four (4) Square in Square – all sizes.
