Block Assembly:

Assemble two Fabric D squares and two Fabric C squares.

Four Patch Unit should measure

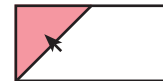
(1 1/4" x 1 1/4") [2" x 2"] {2 3/4" x 2 3/4"}.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric E squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric E square on one end of a Fabric A rectangle.

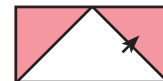
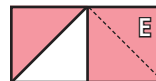
Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



Repeat on the opposite end.

Flying Geese Unit should measure

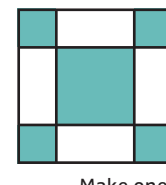
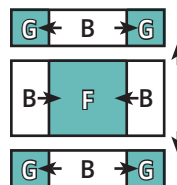
(1 1/4" x 2") [2" x 3 1/2"] {2 3/4" x 5"}.



Assemble four Fabric G squares, four Fabric B rectangles and the Fabric F square.

Center Unit should measure

(2" x 2") [3 1/2" x 3 1/2"] {5" x 5"}.

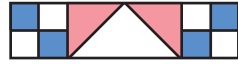
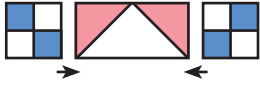


Assemble two Four Patch Units and one Flying Geese Unit.

(1 1/4" x 3 1/2") [2" x 6 1/2"] {2 3/4" x 9 1/2"}.

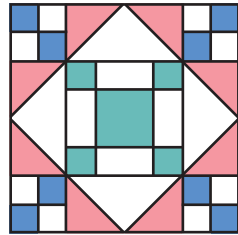
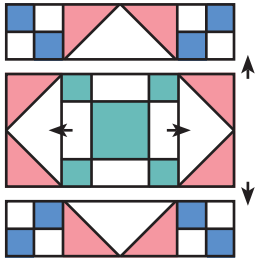
